### A MESSAGE FROM THE MANAGING DIRECTOR

### **COVIDVIRUS RELIEF FOR TENNANTS & LANDLORDS**

The Victorian Government has introduced a Commercial Tenancy Relief Scheme ((including Retail) to alleviate financial hardship faced by tenants and landlords as a result of coronavirus (COVID-19 Omnibus Act 2020).

### What support does the Scheme provide for Commercial tenants and landlords?

- A six-month moratorium on commercial tenancy evictions for the non-payment of rent for small to medium enterprises with an annual turnover under \$50 million that have experienced a minimum 30 per cent reduction in turnover due to coronavirus (COVID-19), commencing from 29 March 2020
- A freeze on rent increases during the moratorium for commercial tenants
- A rent payment waiver or deferral taking into account the commercial tenants' income reduction due to coronavirus (COVID-19), to be negotiated between the tenant and landlord
- A free mediation service for commercial tenants and landlords, accessed through the VSBC, to support fair tenancy negotiations

### **DID YOU KNOW?**

Tip for Commercial Real Estate Agents! Whether you are selling, leasing or managing a commercial property, inspecting agents should be mindful of the Essential Safety Measures (ESMs) available to protect the building.

For example, having evacuation plans on display and providing sound risk management advice may decide the crucial decision for any potential purchaser or tenant and even determine the selection of the best agency person to service applicable enquires.

The Government is also providing land tax relief to commercial or industrial landlords that provide rent relief to their tenants, provided:

- the tenant's annual turnover doesn't exceed \$50 million
- the business is an eligible business in the Commonwealth's Job Keeper scheme, and
- the business is suffering financial stress or hardship as a result of the pandemic.

If a commercial tenant or landlord is in a situation where the tenant is having trouble paying rent because of coronavirus (COVID-19), we recommend tenants keep paying what they can afford, work out what their financial situation is (i.e. what their reduction in turnover is) and talk to their landlord to try to reach an agreement on rent relief. ## EPA TARGETS HAZARDOUS STOCKPILING

With summer fast approaching and recycling waste piling up around the State, the worst environmental fears were triggered following two more waste-fuelled infernos becoming a reality in Campbellfield and Thomastown.

The EPA environmental watchdog and its Environmental Taskforce has investigations underway and is currently identifying and assessing all potential recycling environmental Hazards across Melbourne.

EPA statistics: (Source: EPA/Vic. Gov. Recovery Audit Taskforce)

- More than 800 sites identified, more than 700 assessed
- More than 200 sites require "urgent attention"
- 345 sites have evidence of stockpiles
- 358 on-site inspections across 128 sites have been carried out
- 84 remedial notices and 14 sanctions have been issued.

- Ensure customers and all occupants at your workplace are not exposed to COVIDSAFE risks
- Keep employees consulted on COVIDSAFE matters likely to directly affect Health & Safety

### **CASE STUDY**
